# Ways to prevent the spread of COVID19 in classrooms



Stop COVID19 from spreading in your classroom by following these tips.

Taking a layered approach by implementing as many safe practices as we can helps reduce the risk of spread.

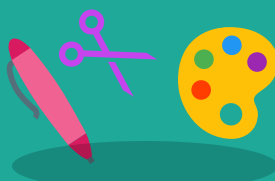
## Maintain safe space



Rearrange desks to make them all face front--do not face each other. Keep as much distance as possible between each student. Place marks on the floor with tape or stickers to remind students of safe distances.

## Avoid sharing objects



Don't pull from a common supply. Students should not share equipment or supplies. If sharing is necessary, create separate bins for clean and dirty supplies. Disinfect between each use.

## Help students practice good hand hygiene



Allow plenty of time for handwashing throughout the day. Teach proper handwashing techniques. Provide hand sanitizer for use in between handwashing.

## Enforce Mask Order



Require all students to keep their masks on and over their nose and mouth. During mask breaks, make sure students maintain proper distance and follow safety protocols.

## Cohort groups



As much as possible, try to keep students cohorted together. This will make it easier to track who has been exposed and limit the amount of contacts to a positive case.

## Be on the lookout for symptoms



If you notice a student with possible COVID19 symptoms, refer them to the nurse for further monitoring. If you are feeling sick while at school, go home as soon as possible.
