Social Distance

Point of Contact

Campuses must designate a point of contact for communication about COVID-19 procedures.

Course Scheduling

Course scheduling and academic programming alternatives should be considered.

Health Monitoring

Require all campus employees to conduct daily health assessments, which should include taking their temperature and monitoring for fever, cough, or trouble breathing.

Communal Spaces

Close shared spaces, such as dining halls, game rooms, exercise rooms, and lounges, if possible.

Laundry Rooms

Restrict the number of people allowed in laundry rooms as well as provide gloves, soap, and EPA approved disinfectants for students to clean high touch areas.

Student Activities & General Campus Events

Minimum six foot social distancing must be preserved to the greatest extent feasible.

Dining Facilities

Provide grab-and-go options for meals. Use disposable food service items, if possible. Close buffets or other self service food areas.

Campus visitors & Gatherings

Pursue virtual group events, gatherings, or meetings, if possible. Limit any nonessential visitors, volunteers, and activities involving external groups or organizations.
